GENERAL NOTICE OF RACE

1. GENERAL

The **2012 Atlantic Watersports Games International Comitee and Organisation Comitee cordially invite the regions and countries of the European Atlantic** to take part in the XIIIth Atlantic Watersports Games.

The Atlantic Watersports Games International Comitee reserves the right to welcome others regions and countries.

The **2012 Atlantic Watersports Games (JNA 2012)** will take place from **16 to 20 July 2012**.

The water sports presented are: rowing, sand yachting, canoeing, kite surfing, fin swimming, stand up paddle racing, surfing, surf life saving and sailing (Disabled sailing), under the authority of following federations:

- FFS Aviron,
- FF Char à voile,
- FF Handisport,
- FF Canoë-Kayak,
- FF Vol Libre,
- FFE Sports Sous Marins,
- FF Surf,
- FF Sauvetage et Secourisme,
- FF Voile.

The sites of competitions will be:

- **Lorient** – rowing,
- **Plouharnel/St Pierre Quiberon** – sand yachting, kite surfing, surfing, Surf Life Saving,
- **St Pierre Quiberon/Quiberon/ENVSN** – sea rowing, ocean racing, fin swimming, stand up paddle racing, sailing (disabled sailing).





2. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The Atlantic Water sports Games are organized by the National school of sailing and water sports (ENVSN) operator of the ministry of sports with the support of the Regional Council of Brittany, the General Council of Morbihan, the Pays d'Auray, the Municipalities of Auray, Quiberon, Lorient, Plouharnel and St Pierre Quiberon and N (NEB).

3. RULES

3.1 the competition will be governed by the Racing Rules of the following International Federations:

- International Sailing Federation (ISAF)
- International Association For Disabled Sailing (IFDS)
- International Canoe Federation (ICF)
- International Rowing Federation (FISA)
- World Underwater Federation (CEMAS)
- European Surfing Federation (ESF)
- International Kiteboarding Association (IKA)
- International Land and Sandyachting Federation (FISLY)
- International Life Saving Federation (ILS)
- The competition rules of the International Committee of the Atlantic Watersports Games
- The 2012 Atlantic Water sports Games general Notice of Race
- The Notice of Race for each sport and the competition Instructions for each discipline.

3.2 Advertising

Competitors may be required to display sponsor advertising supplied by the organizing authority.

3.3 Image rights: filming, reports, indication of names, broadcasting...

Competitors may be:

- Photographed,
- Filmed for the productions of videos and a DVD,
- Interviewed for the press,
- Have their names and images published in the press, the web sites of the Games.

All documents can be used by the International Committee in perpetuity in all forms of media including internet for information and promotion.

4. CLASSES (see appendices)

5. SUPPLIED EQUIPMENT

A sport (including disqualification of the competitor) or financial penalty may be given and the use of a boat may be withdrawn if, in the opinion of the organizing authority, a competitor treats or handles a boat or a board without care or in a manner which causes or is likely to cause damage to the boat or the board.

The organizing authority will not supply technical devices, or accessories, or any other personal equipment.

No modifications to a boat, a board or any other equipment shall be made without unless authorized by the organizing authority.

6. ELIGIBILITY

6.1 Teams and licences

Every competitor must be a member of a club/federation of the country or region which is entering him/her and must hold own the corresponding sport license or have Public Liability insurance. The International Committee will resolve all applications or disputes relating to the determination of the national or the regional authority which a competitor may represent, and their decision will be final.

6.2 Flags of the participating teams

Each team is required to bring to the venues their national or regional flag, in approximate size 2.5 x 1m, and a CD/MP3 with the national or regional anthem.

7. CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

7.1 Teams

The countries and regions must provide before 1th March 2012, as a pre-registration:

- the definitive number of the sports in which they will participate (number of sports teams presented by every country or region),
- the number of competitors of their teams.

7.2 Entries

The entries must be submitted from April 1st 2012, on the web page of the International Committee <http://www.jniea.eu> (contact@jniea.eu), by the national or regional authorities of the competitors taking part in the Atlantic Water sports Games, and before June 15th, 2012, with the payment of the registration fee (40 € by competitor).

Registrations between June 15th and July 6th 2012 will have a registration fee of 55€.

Late entries, after July 6th 2012, will have a registration fee of 70€ per competitor.

Any unpaid or unconfirmed registration in the end of the confirmations of registration on July 16th at 5:00 pm will be cancelled.

If a competitor wants to take part in several sports, he or she will have to pay registration fees for each of the sports he or she wants to take part in.

A competitor taking part in several disciplines of a same sport will only pay one registration fee.

7.3 Tasks of the national or regional authorities

The Team Leaders have to:

- Select the teams
- Gather information from competitors
- Submit team details, the entry applications and fees to the International Committee.
- Collect parental approvals (forms available on www.jniea.eu) and forward them to the International Committee.
- Coordinate and pay for transport of their teams.
- Coordinate and pay for accommodation and catering of their teams.

7.4 Late entries

The Committee reserves the right to accept late entries. (After July 16th 2012).

7.5 Confirmation of the registration

Each competitor's registration will be confirmed on July 15rd from 10 a.m to 6h 30 p.m and on July 16th from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m at the ENVSN.

The following documents will have to be presented:

- Official Sports license (countries or regions having one).
- Public Liability Insurance certificate. (Countries or regions who don't have federative licenses)
- Parental approvals (when necessary).

8. SECURITY

All established safety norms must be respected, generally speaking, and for each different sport.

9. ACCOMMODATION, CATERING

9.1 Plan of accommodation

The Organizing Committee will provide accommodation and catering, from dinner on July 15th 2012 to lunch on July 20th 2012 (5 overnight stays, 5 lunches and 5 dinners).

Four collective places of accommodation are reserved; breakfasts and lunches to be taken will be supplied at each of the places of accommodation.

The dinner will be served at the ENVSN for all the delegations and a shuttle service will be organized between the places of accommodation and the ENVSN.

- The total cost per person of full board accommodation is **220€** for the stay in the Youth hostel in Plouharnel, Home des Pins in St Pierre Quiberon, ENVSN in St Pierre Quiberon and PEP56 in Quiberon.

9.2 Accommodation, booking and payment

10. BOAT RENTAL AND DAMAGE DEPOSITS

10.1 Payment will be required for rental in those sports for which the nautical equipment will be supplied during the duration of the JNA on 2012 from 16 to 20 July :

- Class Fc 7.5 OD Cruiser : 426€ per crew
- Stand Up Paddle: 73,50€ per crew.

Otherwise, for the duration of the JNA on 2012 from 16 till 20 July, it will be possible to rent at the ENVSN:

- Windsurf 293 OD: 73,50€ per crew
- Laser 4.7 or Radial: 168€ per crew.

10.2 Damage deposit for the rental of nautical equipment

The participating teams will have to supply during the confirmation of registration damage deposit of 500€ per Class Fc 7.5 OD Cruiser and 250€ per Stand Up Paddle to cover the possible damages and the losses which they could provoke to the supplied or rented nautical equipment.

The deposit will be the limit of responsibility for each incident; should a deduction be made from the deposit, the competitor concerned will have to restore the initial value to maintain his eligibility as participant.

On Tuesday, July 17th, Wednesday, July 18th, and Thursday, July 19th:

From 9 am to 7 pm: Competitions on sites with schedules adapted to sports

19 pm: Team Leaders meeting

Activities during the day on sites of competition

Activities in the evening in Quiberon peninsula

On Friday, July 20th:

½ spare day for competition

2 pm, proclamation of the results on each of the sites of competitions

4 pm closing ceremony in St Pierre Quiberon,

Departure of delegations.

12 SCORING

The scoring in each class (discipline) will be valid if at least 5 countries or regions are represented in the relevant class (discipline).

Each sport committee will establish the scoring system in its race instructions.

The system of scoring of Countries or Regions will be the system of the international Committee (Counting of the number of golden medals obtained by every Country or Region in the disciplines).

13 PARTICULAR INSTRUCTIONS

The particular instructions will be available for all competitors at registration confirmation in ENVSN.

14 INTERNATIONAL JURY

Where possible, in all the disciplines competing, an international jury will be appointed by the Organization Committee with the agreement of the International Committee.

15 DRUG TESTING

Drug testing may take place during the competition.

16 MEASUREMENT

Measurement checks may be carried out by the race committees at any time on any boat or board to ensure compliance with the rules.

17 LIABILITY

The competitors take part in the Games under their own responsibility.

Neither the organizing authority nor any person or entities involved in the organization of the event accept any liability for injury or loss of life or property caused by or in conjunction with the Games.

The competitor is free to choose to participate or not in a competition.

The Organization Committee may demand payment of any damage provoked by the wrong use of nautical installations and official accommodation. It may also evict any competitor for bad behavior, independently from the actions of the Jury.

18 PRIZES

The following prizes will be awarded:

- Individual prize for the 1st three of each discipline (if a minimum of 5 invited countries or regions take part in each discipline),
- Sport country results for the 1st 3 countries (if a minimum of 5 invited countries or regions take part in each sport).
- Overall country ranking all sports included for the 1st 3 countries (if a minimum of 5 invited countries or regions take part in the Games)
